I) Profile:

The library is considered as the nerve centre of any R&D institute. Its role has changed from being a mere storehouse of books and journals to Library & Information centre (LIC)/ Knowledge resource centre (KRC). It is closely linked with the speed and direction of R&D. Some one has rightly said that Library can exist on its own but any research institute cannot exist without library.

The facilities which are extended by library comprises of Documentation Services, Inhouse Consultation, Inter-Library Loan, Retrospective Bibliographical Literature Search and Reprographic Services etc.

III) Journals:

Journals are the vital source of information for the scientific research and development. The number of journals at present is estimated to be ~ 250,000. Of these, ~ 25,000 are scientific, technical and medical journal, ~ 15,000 are refereed scholarly periodicals and ~ 12,000 are refereed scholarly periodicals which are available online. Journals titles are growing three folds every 15 years and their cost, 2.5 times every 10

years. Obviously no single library can afford to procure all journals even in a single discipline.

1) **Books Acquisition**

Major activities of this section are:

VII) Collections

The Collection of the CIMFR (Digwadih campus) Library is in the area of Fuel and its allied subjects are very strong. The Collection comprises mainly with books, theses, pamphlets, reports, current journals, back volumes, specifications, standards, patents, microfiche, microfilms, CD-ROM databases etc. The collection is heavily used by the Scientist & Technical staffs, students, industrial associates, project coordinators, special members, scholars etc.

a) Collection Development:

CIMFR (Digwadih Campus) Library continued building up its collection by acquisition of new books/ journals as per the requirements of the Scientists/ Staff Members of the various Departments. During the period under review (2006-07), the Library procured, processed and made available 152 books (48 English + 104 Hindi) and 13 books by Gratis. The total number of books available in the Library has risen to over 11,711.

Besides this, the Library subscribed to around 76 (34 Foreign + 42 Indian) national/ international scientific and technical journals and around 12 such journals were received on gratis. The library has bounded volumes of journals more than 35000 in number.

b) Computerized Catalogue:

The Computerized catalogue of Books 'Granthalaya' available in the Library is being used continuously by users and the total number of machine-readable records now stands at over 10,500.

Infrastructure of Library

1) Reading Space (Books)

It is located on the 1st floor of library building. The proper guide has been provided at the prominent place which is directly visible to the users and also the main subjects have been displayed on the end panel of each book shelves. This stack has the book collection basically on (Fuel and allied subjects, Chemistry, Coal, Geological Science, Civil, Electronics, Computer Science, environmental science etc.).

2) Reading Space (Current Journals)

The entire current journals received in the Library are displayed in specially designed Wooden Display Racks Kept in 1st floor 'current periodicals space' in alphabetical order.

3) Reading Space (periodical Back volumes)

It is located at 2nd floor of library building. The back volumes of the periodical are arranged alphabetically as per the titles. Various specification and reports are also available in the library.

VIII) Membership

The CIMFR (Digwadih Campus) Library enrolls members strictly only to the staffs. We also encourage other users to use our library with due letter of permission addressed to Director, CIMFR (Digwadih Campus), forwarding to the Head Library, mentioning the time duration to utilize library.
